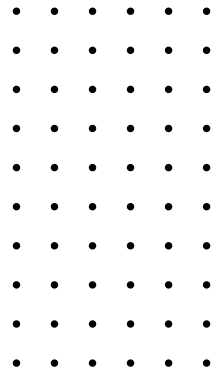


INTRODUCTION

ACTIVITY REPORT

2023-2024

PIGGERY FARMING PROJECT

- **Funding:** International Ministry Dimapur, Nagaland
- **Implementation:** Three villages of Nartap Gaon Panchayat
- **Beneficiaries:** 15 families
- **Objective:** Income generation for beneficiaries
- **Outcome:** 15 families received 2 piglets each. Beneficiaries are required to donate 2 piglets to other poor families after the first breeding.



CLOTHS DISTRIBUTION

- **Funding:** Rotary Club Guwahati Luhit
- **Beneficiaries:** 350 children from Chamata Pathar, Garbhanga, and Latum villages
- **Objective:** Provide clothing to needy children
- **Outcome:** 350 children received new clothes.



TAILORING SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

- **Funding:** Rotary Club Guwahati Luhit
- **Beneficiaries:** 350 children from Chamata Pathar, Garbhanga, and Latum villages
- **Objective:** Provide clothing to needy children
- **Outcome:** 350 children received new clothes.





MENSTRUAL HYGIENE AWARENESS PROGRAM

- **Collaboration:** Chetana Ladies Club
- **Beneficiaries:** 95 girls students from Dikchak, Sakonibari, Namgaon, and Kharikata villages
- **Objective:** Raise awareness about menstrual hygiene
- **Outcome:** 95 girls attended the program. Sanitary pads and study materials were distributed.
